The Imagine Series 351 captivates the audience and organist with magnificent true-to-life pipe organ samples. The organ features 51 main pipe organ stops, including Chimes and Zimbelstern. Each drawknob represents four selectable stops, resulting in a total of 198 Voice Palette™ stops spread across 4 unique organ styles: American Eclectic, English Cathedral, French Romantic and German Baroque.
